Organization Plan 2024-2025

- K4(21), K5(27), Grades 1(27), 2(37), 5(43) & 6(42) all have 2 classes allocated to them
- Grades 3(37) & 4(36) have 1 × Grade 3(26) class, 1 × Grade 4(24) & a 1 × Grade 3/4
 (23) split
- The split is due to numbers in the Grade 3 & 4 grade levels; this would have us with 1 over max class in Grade 4

- A discussion was held with regards to the split class model
- Questions, concerns & a discussion ensued around the educational impact on the students in a split situation
